Art-in-Science Submission Requirements

Resources for displaying art submissions to the AiS show are limited. AiS staff and volunteers will make their best efforts to exhibit all submissions, but it may not be possible to display them all. By submitting, you are acknowledging that you understand these limitations, and that you will adhere to the following guidelines to assist us in displaying your art.

Limit

Each artist is limited to submitting 3 works, per year.

Digital Submissions

All digital submissions must be made *via the registration form* on the AiS website. For 2D static art, submissions must be printable on commonly available color (eg, inkjet) printers and standard US Letter (8.5 x 11 inch) paper. Larger print formats (eg, 11 x 17 inch) may be requested but are not guaranteed to be available. For 2D animations or movies, gif or mp4 formats are strongly preferred; other formats may not be supportable.

Physical (in-person) Submissions

All physical submissions must be *clearly labelled* (eg, on the rear of the artwork) *with the artist's name and contact information*. For 2D art, they should also be already *prepared for mounting*, eg matted or framed, optionally with wires, hooks, or other hardware. Mounting resources for physical art will be limited to (eg) falcon board on easels, pre-existing wall hooks in display areas, or similar, and artists should bear this in mind before submission. For 3D art or installations (Colorado only), submissions may be limited to a size which will fit into modest display cases. The exact size limit is uncertain, but the larger the art, the more difficult it may be to display.

All physical submissions will be made available for pickup by artists only, or to 3rd parties with prior arrangement, after the AiS show. Any submissions which have not been picked up by 1 week (7 calendar days) after the show ends will be disposed of at the discretion of AiS staff and volunteers.

Sales

No art sales activity will be supported by AiS staff or volunteers in any way. However, if they wish, artists are free to make their own arrangements for sales, separate from the AiS shows.
